GSAFE provides high quality and engaging trainings for educators, students, community members, and families focused on the needs of LGBTQ+ Youth.

GSAFE has a Certified Welcoming Schools Facilitator on staff. Welcoming Schools is a comprehensive approach to creating respectful and supportive elementary schools with resources and professional development to:

- Embrace family diversity
- Create LGBTQ-inclusive schools
- Prevent bias-based bullying and gender stereotyping
- Support transgender and gender expansive students

Most Welcoming Schools training modules are 90-120 minutes in length and can be presented in two parts; however, both parts must be scheduled at the same time.

Fees for trainings and presentations fund curriculum development, research, staff training, and administrative tasks to provide high quality experiences. Note that additional fees for mileage (current state rate), lodging, and meals may be applied to training costs.

GSAFE is committed to ensuring that our trainings and presentations are accessible to all communities, and offers a sliding fee scale on a limited, case-by-case basis.
